Ordinance No. 2004-13 Passed NOVEMBER 16, 20 04

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE 2004 COMPREHENSIVE LAND PLAN UPDATE OF THE CITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO.

WHEREAS, Council and Planning Commission established a committee to review and update the Comprehensive Land Plan of the City of Brookville; and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Land Plan committee has prepared and approved a Comprehensive Land Plan Update, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Planning Commission has recommended to Council that the proposed Comprehensive Land Plan Update be adopted; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that the proposed Comprehensive Land Plan Update will assist the City of Brookville in the orderly development of the community, and that the Comprehensive Land Plan Update should be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: That the City of Brookville 2004 Comprehensive Land Plan Update is hereby approved and adopted. A copy of the 2004 Comprehensive Land Plan Update is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after passage pursuant to the Charter of the City of Brookville.
