

ORDINANCE NO. 1999-06

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE TO DONATE CERTAIN UNCLAIMED PROPERTY TO PUBLIC AGENCIES AND NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS.

WHEREAS, Ohio House Bill 55, effective September 29, 1999, amended certain provisions of the Revised Code to permit municipal police departments to dispose of certain unclaimed property by donating it to public agencies or non-profit organizations if authorized by the legislative authority of the municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Brookville desires to authorize the Police Department to donate certain unclaimed property to public agencies or non-profit organizations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO:

SECTION 1:

The Chief of Police of the Brookville Police Department is hereby authorized with the approval of the Municipal Manager to donate certain unclaimed property to public agencies and non-profit organizations as permitted by Section 737.32 of the Revised Code.

SECTION 2:

This Ordinance shall revoke and rescind any Ordinance, Resolution, or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions, in conflict herewith.

SECTION 3:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage pursuant to the Charter of the Municipality of Brookville.
