AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 36.02 (A) COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 8.02 B of the Municipal Charter provides that Council shall establish by Ordinance an amount at which competitive bidding shall be required to purchase goods and services for the Municipality and the procedure to be followed in the competitive bidding process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO;

SECTION I:


That Section 36.02 (A) shall be amended to read as follows: All contracts for goods or services, others than the compensation of persons employed by the Municipality, in an amount in excess of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) which are not exempt from competitive bidding by Section 8.02 B of the Municipal Charter, shall first be authorized by motion of Council after the completion of the competitive procedure as provided herein.


SECTION II:

That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency and shall take effect immediately upon passage by Council as set forth in the Charter of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio.




