Ordinance No. 1993-04

Passed APRIL 20, 1993

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TIME PERIOD FOR DOOR TO DOOR SOLICITATION BY PROFIT AND NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS AND INDIVIDUALS.

WHEREAS, it has been deemed necessary to establish a time period for door to door solicitation by profit and non-profit organizations and individuals to address the concerns of the citizens of Brookville about early morning and late evening solicitation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO, THAT:

Section I:

Door to door solicitation by profit or non-profit organizations and individuals shall be limited to the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on each day of the week.

Section II:

Door to door solicitation at any time other than during the time period expressed in Section I shall violate this Ordinance and shall be a minor degree misdemeanor.

Section III:

This Ordinance shall revoke and rescind all Ordinances, parts of Ordinances and Resolutions and parts of Resolutions that are in conflict herewith and shall be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
