Ordinance No. 1992-02

Passed February 4, 19 92

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE IN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO WITHOUT REASONABLE CONTROL AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has enacted Section 4511.202 of the Ohio Revised Code setting forth that no one in the State of Ohio shall operate a motor vehicle without reasonable control: and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio, desire to keep their traffic ordinances similar to those promulgated by the State of Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I:

No person shall operate a motor vehicle, trackless trolley, or streetcar on any street, highway, or property open to the public for vehicular traffic without being in reasonable control of the vehicle, trolley, or streetcar.

SECTION II:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a two-thirds majority of council as provided for in the chart of Municipality of Brookville, Ohio.




