

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 1991-17

Passed November 19, 1991

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE STOP SIGNS AT CERTAIN STREETS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO, AND DECLARING THIS AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary for the safety of the users of the Municipal streets for the Council to designate another street as a stop street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO:

## SECTION I:

That the intersection of Westbrook Road and Mosier Drive shall be made a one-way stop street and that one stop sign be erected on the northwest corner of the said intersection facing south bound traffic onto Westbrook Road off Mosier Drive thereby making the intersection of Mosier Drive and Westbrook Road a one-way stop.

## SECTION II:

That the intersection of Carr Drive and Mosier Drive shall be made a one-way stop street and that one stop sign be erected on the southeast corner of the said intersection facing north bound traffic onto Carr Drive off Mosier Drive thereby making the intersection of Mosier Drive and Carr Drive a one-way stop.

## SECTION III:

That the intersection of Mosier Drive and Carr Drive shall be made a two-way stop street, and further that two stop signs be erected; one at the southwest corner of the said intersection of Carr Drive and Mosier Drive facing east bound traffic; and that a stop sign be erected on the northeast corner facing west bound traffic, thereby making the intersection of Carr Drive and Mosier Drive a two-way stop.

## SECTION IV:

That the intersection of Carr Drive and Parker Drive shall be made a one-way stop street and that one stop sign be erected on the northwest corner of the said intersection facing south bound traffic onto Carr Drive off Parker Drive thereby making the intersection of Parker Drive and Carr Drive a one-way stop.

## SECTION V:

That the intersection of Arlington Road and South Parkview Drive shall be made a one-way stop street and that one stop sign be erected on the southwest corner of the said intersection facing east bound traffic onto Arlington Road off South Parkview Drive thereby making the intersection of South Parkview Drive and Arlington Road a one-way stop.

## SECTION VI:

That the intersection of North Parkview Drive and South Parkview Drive shall be made a one-way stop street and that one stop sign be erected on the north-east corner of the said intersection facing west bound traffic onto North Parkview Drive off South Parkview Drive thereby making the intersection of South Parkview Drive and North Parkview Drive a one way stop.

## SECTION VII:

This Ordinance shall rescind any part of any other Ordinance that is in conflict herewith.

## SECTION VIII:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a two-thirds majority of Council as provided for in the Charter of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio.




