Ordinance No. 1990-13

Passed October 16, 1990

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A STOP SIGN BEFORE THE RAILROAD TRACK ON ALBERT ROAD WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO, AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been deemed necessary for the safety of the users of the Municipal streets for the Council to designate another street as a stop street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I:

That there shall be a stop sign erected on the south side of the railroad track facing north bound traffic on Albert Road in the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio.

SECTION II:

This Ordinance shall rescind any part of any other ordinance that is in conflict herewith.

SECTION III:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens to the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
