Ordinance No. 1987-04

Passed May 5, 1987

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL STOP STREETS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO, SPECIFICALLY AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF ARLINGTON ROAD AND WOLFCREEK PIKE BY MEANS OF ADDING OR CHANGING VARIOUS STOP SIGNS AND YIELD SIGNS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the traffic patterns have been altered at the intersection of Arlington Road and Wolfcreek Pike due to increased traffic on these streets; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the necessity to change certain traffic patterns for increased safety, it is deemed necessary to erect various stop signs and/or yield signs for this particular intersection; and

WHEREAS, it is now deemed necessary for the safety and welfare of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio, for the council of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio, to designate the intersection of Arlington Road and Wolfcreek Pike as a three-way stop street and to further designate the westbound/northbound traffic from Wolfcreek Pike on to Arlington Road as a yield street and to direct the Municipal Manager to erect appropriate stop signs and/or yield signs at said intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO:

SECTION I.

That the intersection of Arlington Road and Wolfcreek Pike shall be made a three-way stop street and a stop sign shall be erected on the southeast corner of the intersection at Arlington Road and Wolfcreek Pike with the said stop sign facing the northbound traffic at Arlington Road; that a stop sign shall be erected on the northwest corner of Arlington Road and Wolfcreek Pike (including the newly created entrance and exit into Boose Chevrolet's parking lot facing the southbound traffic on Arlington Road; that a stop sign shall be erected on the island at the intersection of Wolfcreek Pike and Arlington Road facing the westbound traffic on Wolfcreek Pike; and that a further stop sign be erected on the southwest corner of the said intersection facing eastbound traffic exiting from the newly created intersection on to and off from Boose Chevrolet's parking lot; all the said stop signs to be erected being located within the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio.

SECTION II.

That the intersection of Arlington Road and Wolfcreek Pike going westbound off of Wolfcreek Pike and merging into the northbound lane of Arlington Road shall be made a yield street for

traffic flowing in that direction; that an appropriate yield sign shall be erected on the northeast corner of the said intersection, said yield sign being located within the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio.

SECTION III.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date it has been passed according to the charter of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio.
