Ordinance No. 1984-02

Passed March 6, 1984

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF THE STREET CURRENTLY KNOWN AS PERRY STREET, WITHIN THE CORPORATION LIMITS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO, TO THE NAME OF WESTBROOK ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, the street that is commonly called Westbrook Road within the corporate limits of the Municipality has been known by that name for many years; and

Whereas, in some sections of that street the official name is still Perry Street; and

Whereas, it is deemed necessary in order to provide for the welfare of the citizens of the community to have consistency in the naming of the Municipality's streets.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Council of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio, that:

SECTION I:

The street formerly known as Perry Street has its name changed to the name of Westbrook Road.


SECTION II:

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and welfare of the citizens of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio, and shall be in force from and after its passage by two-thirds (2/3) majority of the Council of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio.
