Ordinance No. 1984-06

Passed JULY 3, 1984

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 52.10 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO, BY ESTABLISHING A CHARGE FOR COMMERCIAL BUSINESS FOR THE COLLECTION OF TIRES BY THE MUNICIPALITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, LET IT BE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I:

Section 52.10 of the Code of Ordinances of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio, shall be amended to include Paragraph D as follows:

(Paragraph D)

A charge of \$55 per tire shall be charged any business place or commercial business where the Municipality picks up any tire or tires while providing trash and garbage collection for that said business place or commercial business.

SECTION II:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance in order to protect the general health and welfare of the community and its environs. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage by the members of council as pursuant to Section 4.07(A)(5) of the Municipal Charter.
