Ordinance No. 1984-10

Passed November 20, 1984

AN ORDINANCE REQUESTING CERTIFICATION TO ENFORCE THE OHIO BASIC BUILDING CODE WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio desires to enforce the Ohio Basis Building Code (hereinafter referred to as OBBC) for the purpose of providing uniform standards and requirements for the erection, construction, repair, alteration, and maintenance of buildings, including the construction of industrialized units; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio seeks to obtain the authority to enforce the provisions of OBBC through certification by the Ohio Board of Building Standards pursuant to Section 3781.10 (E) of the Revised Code, therefore

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio:

SECTION I.

That Chapters 4101:2-1 to 4101:2-51 of the Ohio Administrative Code, collectively known as the "Ohio Basis Building Code," shall apply and be enforced within the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio.


SECTION II.
