Ordinance No. 1982-02

Passed FEBRUARY 16, 1982

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #307, BY REPEALING SECTION 4 OF THE SAID ORDINANCE IN ALLOWING THOSE MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS TO OPERATE COIN OPERATED VIDEO GAMES AND OTHER AMUSEMENT DEVICES IN A PUBLIC PLACE.

WHEREAS, there now exists a large number of coin operated Video Games available to the public which would not be harmful to those persons under 18 years of age.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio that:

SECTION I:

Ordinance #307, Section 4., declaring it unlawful for those persons under 18 years of age to operate any mechanical amusement devise shall hereinafter be repealed.


SECTION II:

This Ordinance shall take affect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
