AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #111.01 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO AND PROVIDING FOR THE REQUIREMENT OF A LICENSE; THE APPLICATION FOR THE LICENSE; AND A FEE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary for the general safety and welfare of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio, that new billiard and pool room license requirements and fees be established, and that this Ordinance be deemed an emergency Ordinance and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO THAT:

## SECTION I:

Ordinance #111.01 of the Code of Ordinances of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio shall be amended to read as follows: Any person or persons desiring to open, maintain or operate a billiard or pool room in the Municipality shall file a written and signed application with the Mayor setting forth therein the location of said proposed billiard and pool room, number of billiard or pool tables that it will contain and the names of all persons interested or concerned therein. There upon the Mayor, should the room named in the application conform to the requirements hereof, upon payment to him of a annual license fee of twenty-five and 00/100 (\$25.00) dollars for one such table and twenty-five and 00/100 (\$25.00) dollars for one such bowling alley, and ten and 00/100 (\$10.00) dollars for each additional table and bowling alley, payable annually, shall issue to the applicant or applicants a license to open, maintain, or operate a billiard or pool room or bowling alley in the Municipality at the location and containing the number of tables or bowling alleys as set forth in the application for a period of one year from the date of the license, subject to the provisions of Sections 111.01 through 111.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio.

## SECTION II:

This Ordinance shall rescind any Ordinances or Resolutions or any parts thereof that may be in conflict herewith.

## SECTION III:

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency Ordinance, the reason for the emergency being a necessity to preserve the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Municipality of Brookville, and therefore, shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, provided passage is by at least 2/3 of the members of council.
