AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #307, SECTION 4., BY ALLOWING MINORS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE TO OPERATE COIN OPERATED VIDEO GAMES IN ANY PUBLIC PLACE.

WHEREAS, there now exists a large number of coin operated Video Games available to the public which would not be harmful to those persons under 18 years of age.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Municipality of Brookville, Ohio that:

SECTION 1.

Ordinance #307, Section 4., declaring it unlawful for those persons under 18 years of age to operate any mechanical amusement devise shall be amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for a licensee to permit any person under eighteen (18) years of age to operate such a mechanical amusement devise with the exception of any musical devise or coin operated video game which licensee may permit a minor under eighteen (18) years of age to operate provided it not be used for gambling purposes.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall take affect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
