

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE FOR THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT INCOME TAXES; AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 193 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Brookville, the City imposes a City-wide income tax for the purpose of general municipal operations, maintenance, new equipment and extensions and enlargement of municipal services and facilities of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §131.02, the Ohio Attorney General's Office can collect past due debt on behalf of political subdivisions that choose to participate; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Ohio State Attorney General's office to assist in the collection of delinquent City income taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager should be authorized to enter into an agreement with the Ohio State Attorney General's office for the collection of delinquent City income taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of the agreement with the Ohio State Attorney General's office is on file in the office of the Finance Director; and

**WHEREAS**, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City, and to ensure that the office of the Ohio Attorney General has sufficient time to collect unpaid taxes during the federal and state filing periods;


NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Brookville, State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION I:** The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the office of the Ohio State Attorney General for the collection of delinquent City income taxes, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Finance Director.

**SECTION II:** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure that is necessary to meet an emergency in the government of the City to immediately address the timely collection of delinquent City income tax and therefore shall take effect immediately after passage of this Resolution as provided in 4.07(A)(5) of the Charter of the City of Brookville, Ohio.


