Resolution No. 24-22 Passed November 19, 20 24

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO TO HOLD A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF BROOKVILLE ON JANUARY 7, 2025 ON THE RECALL OF MAYOR CHARLES LETNER.

WHEREAS, Section 10.03 of the Charter of the City of Brookville provides electors of the City of Brookville with the power to remove from office, by recall election, any member of the Council if the member has served at least six months of his term; and

WHEREAS, Section 10.03 provides that a petition for recall is required to be signed by electors of the City of Brookville equal in number to 25% of the number of votes cast at the last regular municipal election.

WHEREAS, a petition for recall of Mayor Charles Letner was filed with the Clerk of Council on October 17, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the petition for recall was submitted to the Montgomery County Board of Elections for verification of petition signatures; and

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Board of Elections found that the required number of signatures of electors of the City of Brookville to place this recall of Charles Letner on the ballot is 553 valid signatures, and the Board of Elections verified 739 valid signatures of the electors of the City of Brookville on the petition; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2024 the Clerk of Council certified to City Council that the petition is sufficient to require that the recall of Charles Letner be placed on the ballot and delivered a copy of the certification of the recall petition to Charles Letner.

WHEREAS, Charles Letner has not resigned within five days after the Clerk of Council delivered a copy of the certification of the recall petition.

WHEREAS, Section 10.03(C) of the Charter of the City of Brookville requires that City Council fix a day for holding a recall election, not less than 60 days nor more than 75 days after the date of delivery of the notice to the officer sought to be recalled that the Clerk has certified that the recall petition is sufficient to require a recall election to be held, and the council member has not resigned within the five day period after receipt of the notice of the certification of the recall petition by the Clerk of Council.






