

BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
“YOUTH IN GOVERNMENT”
BROOKVILLE HIGH SCHOOL AUDITORIUM, 7:30 PM
MAY 27, 1999

The Special Meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Dafler at 7:30PM on May 27, 1999 in the Brookville High School Auditorium. Member's Dafler, Duncan, Imler, Trimble, Seagraves and Shellabarger; Law Director Stephan, Manager Wright, Clerk Yost, Fire Chief Nickel and Sergeant Summers were present. Member Garber was absent.

Mayor Dafler welcomed everyone, and gave a brief presentation of “Youth In Government,” stating that this is the 24th year. Mayor Dafler introduced the “Youth In Government” Officials, and presented them with “Certificates of Participation” as they assumed their positions from the regular officials.

Motion by Imler, second by Duncan to accept the Agenda as presented, with correction. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Duncan, second by Imler to accept the May 18, 1999 Regular Meeting Minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

The following Citizen's Comments were recognized.

Mr. Mark Brown, BHS Government Teacher, discussed how the “Youth In Government” program works. He also read various “memorable” student comments, heard from the participating seniors in this year’s program.

Reports were given by the various “Youth In Government” Officials with no additional reports by the regular officials.

There were no reports of Boards, Commissions or Committees.

Reading of Ordinances, Resolutions & Written Motions.

Motion by Duncan, second by Imler to read proposed Resolution No. 99-12. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, second by Duncan to accept the third, and final reading and adopt Resolution No. 99-12 entitled, “A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO DISPOSE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY EITHER AT A PUBLIC AUCTION-OR-AT-A-PRIVATE SALE.” All yeas, motion carried.

“Youth In Government” Council Member Stephanie Rives discussed the issue of traffic congestion at the intersection of Arlington Road and Upper Lewisburg-Salem Road at the bikeway. “Youth In Government” Mayor Luke Westerman stated that the issue would be looked into. “Youth In Government” Manager Jason Stephan jokingly suggested that additional travel time be used when negotiating that particular intersection.

Also, “Youth In Government” Council Member Traci Duncan discussed a request to install one or more information boards at the edge of town. “Youth In Government” Mayor Luke Westerman stated that this issue, also, would be looked into.

Mayor Dafler stated, that these two issues initiated by the “Youth In Government” Officials, will be discussed at the June 1st Regular Meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council.

There was no Old Business.

Motion by Imler, second by Seagraves to adjourn. All yeas, motion carried.
