SPECIAL MEETING  
“YOUTH IN GOVERNMENT”

Reports were given by the various “Youth In Government Officials” with no additions to the reports by the regular officials.



Mayor Dafler presented a “Certificate of Achievement” to Law Director Stephan for his work on establishing the Brookville Enterprise Zone. Law Director Stephan responded with remarks of appreciation.
