Law Director Stephan gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to accept the first reading of proposed Ordinance No. 1996-01. All yeas, motion carried.


Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to go into Executive Session on a real estate matter, as requested by Manager Wright. All yeas, motion carried.
