

BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
November 21, 1995

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Duncan at 7:30 P.M. on November 21, 1995 in the Municipal Council Room. Members Dafler, Garber, Imler, Seagraves, Shellabarger and Trimble; and Law Director Stephan were present. Manager Wright was absent.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Imler to accept the Agenda as presented, with addition. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to accept the November 7, 1995 Regular Meeting Minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Council toured the new Police and Communications Departments with Police Chief Papanek conducting the tour, explaining working plans and answering questions.

Citizen Comments: Larry Henry, Superintendent of Brookville Schools had questions on Council action to permit a fence to be put across the alley from Westbrook Road back to school property; and gave a presentation on why it shouldn't be closed off. Discussion followed with Council to check into the situation some more.

Dottie Watkins, representing the Brookville Historical Society requested being able to put in a bike bench (that would be donated) to place on bikeway property between the Depot and Hay Avenue. Discussion followed.

Motion by Dafler, seconded by Imler to accept and permit the Brookville Historical Society to install a bike bench along the bikeway between the Depot and Hay Avenue, with Manager Wright and the Historical Society to agree on proper location. All yeas, motion carried.


Finance Director Roeser gave a report for Manager Wright which was informative with no action required, and requested a short executive session concerning a personnel matter.


Mayor Duncan gave his report with no action taken.
