

BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
MAY 4, 1993

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Duncan at 7:30 P.M. on May 4, 1993 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Dafler, Garber, Imler, Seagraves and Trimble; Manager Wright and Law Director Stephan were present.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dafler to accept the Agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dafler to approve the April 20, 1993 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Citizen Comments: Mrs. Buckley questioned whether parking on both sides of Coronado Drive will continue to be permitted due to the width of the street in getting the fire trucks through. This will be looked into.

Manager Wright gave his report; update on E. Westbrook Road Sanitary Sewer proposed project and hearing, and the following action was taken:

Motion by Imler, seconded by Ausra to proceed with the Sanitary Sewer Project on E. Westbrook Road from Albert Road to the east corporation line as recommended by the Manager. The Municipality is to work with the property owners on emptying and filling in their septic system; plus connecting to main sewer line due to the cost of project and the front footage of lots; provided property owner connect into the system within one year of completion of the sewer project. All yeas, motion carried.

Finance Director Roeser gave his report with following action taken:

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dafler to accept the April 30, 1993 Fund Balance as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to read proposed Ordinance No. 1993-05. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Imler to accept the third reading and adopt Ordinance No. 1993-05 entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TITLE 5, SECTION 52.10 - AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE RATES AND CHARGES TO ALL REFUSE CUSTOMERS SERVICED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO". All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dafler to adjourn. All yeas, motion carried.
