

BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
May 25, 1993

The special meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Duncan on May 25, 1993 at 7:45 P.M. in the Brookville High School Auditorium. After a welcome to the Youth-In-Government Council meeting by Mayor Duncan, introduction of the Village Municipal Council and officers, presentation of plaques was given to Mitch Reed, former Mayor Apgar and former Manager Robert Wright for starting the Youth-In-Government program. Certificates of Participation were presented to the Youth-In-Government officials and they then assumed their seats. Members Ausra, Dafler, Garber, Imler, Seagraves and Trimble; Manager Wright, Law Director Stephan, Police Chief Papanek and Fire Chief Nichel were present.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to accept the Agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dafler to approve the May 18, 1993 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Reports were given by the various student officials and there were no addition to students reports by the regular officials and so there was no action taken.

Student Mayor read a Proclamation to proclaim the week of May 24 - 30 as "Mitch Reed Appreciation Week in Brookville".

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dafler to read proposed Resolution No. 93-15. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to accept the second reading of proposed Resolution No. 93-15. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dafler to read proposed Resolution No. 93-16. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dafler to accept the first reading, dispense with the second and third reading and adopt Resolution No. 93-16 entitled "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE TO BECOME A MEMBER OF THE NORTHERN MIAMI VALLEY LOCAL GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION, AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY". All yeas, motion carried.

Student Council passed their recommendations that they wanted the Regular Council to consider.

1. Look into the parking at the corner of Sycamore & Market Streets in front of Doc's Pub due to being hard to see when entering Market Street.
2. Signs around the community directing traffic to school and/or football field.
3. Add Mitch Reed Way to Hill Street in front of High School in his honor.

Consensus of Regular Council was to take the recommendations under advisement.
