

BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
MAY 26, 1992

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Duncan at 7:30 P.M. on May 26, 1992 to continue the May 19, 1992 regular meeting. Members Dafler, Garber, Imler, Seagraves and Trimble; Manager Wright Law Director Zuhl, Police Chief Papanek and Fire Chief Nickel were present. Member Ausra was absent.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to accept the Agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dafler to approve the May 19, 1992 portion of the regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Mayor Duncan gave some opening remarks on the Youth-In-Government Program and introduced Council and Municipal Officials.

Mayor Duncan presented Certificates of Award to Kelly Lipinski for achievement in sports and Andy Weaver for achievement in public speaking. Also presented to Brookville's Police Sergeant Preston a Certificate of Award for achievement of being selected and going through the F.B.I. Academy.

Reports were given by the various students officials and there were no addition to student reports by the regular officials. There was no action taken.

Student Mayor read a Proclamation to proclaim the week of May 25 - 31, 1992 as "Mitch Reed Week In Brookville". Also the student government recommended a street be named "Reed Way" after Mitch Reed.

Mayor Duncan presented Certificate of Participation to the Youth-In-Government Officials and gave his report with the following action taken:

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Imler to terminate the Recreation Committee that was first formed with members appointed in August 1985 and to approve the recommendation of the Committee to disburse the final remaining funds for recreation use. All yeas, motion carried.

Mayor Duncan presented the check to the Brookville Booster Club from the Recreation Committee being disbanded.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Dafler to take under consideration the recommendation of the Youth-In-Government Council to name a street, "Reed Way", after Mitch Reed. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to adjourn. All yeas, motion carried.
