

BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING  
JULY 3, 1990

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Duncan at 7:30 P.M. on July 3, 1990 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Dafler, Garber, Imler and Seagraves; Manager Wright and Law Director Zuhl were present. Member Mc Cauley was absent.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Dafler to accept the Agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dafler to approve the June 19, 1990 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken:

Motion by Dafler, seconded by Imler to enter into a Cooperation Agreement with the Board of County Commissioners for the fiscal years 1991, 1992 and 1993 to apply for and receiving grants from the Community Development Block Grant Program. All yeas, motion carried.

Finance Director Roeser gave his report with the following action taken:

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to approve the June 30, 1990 Fund Balance as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

No action was taken on the request for a block party on N. Orchard St., a request from more neighborhood people is needed.

Council was recessed for the Public Hearing on the 1991 Tax Budget.

Finance Director Roeser presented the 1991 Budget by briefly going over the Budget and answering questions. Only one citizen attended the Hearing besides Council.

Mayor Duncan called Council back to Regular Session.


Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Imler to accept and approve the 1991 Tax Budget as presented. All yeas, motion carried.
