

BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
OCTOBER 03, 1989

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Duncan at 7:30 P.M. on October 3, 1989 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Imler, Keener and Seagraves; Manager Wright and Law Director Zuhl were present with Members Dafler and Garber arriving later.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Imler to accept the Agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to approve the September 19, 1989 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Vice President Joe Gorman of Sinclair Community College gave a presentation on the college and the need for more money and asked Council for an endorsement of Sinclair's 2.5 mill tax levy on the November ballot.

Members Dafler and Garber arrived during the presentation.

Motion by Duncan, seconded by Imler to endorse Sinclair Community College's 2.5 mill tax levy that will be on the November ballot. All yeas, motion carried.

Two citizens on Hill Street across from the school asked for a speed bump be installed in the alley coming from the school parking lot on to Hill Street and make the Hill Street and McKinley Street intersection a three (3) way stop and install speed signs. Discussion followed and Council will try to have a recommendation at the next Council meeting.

K. C. Mosier gave a presentation on his land offer to the Municipality offering it at a reduced price from the original proposal. He also asked for an official note on the new proposal. Discussion was held on the proposal and the consensus was to take action at the next meeting.

Manager Wright gave his report with no action taken.

Mayor Duncan gave his report with no action taken.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dafler to read proposed Resolution No. 89-20. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to accept the second reading of proposed Resolution No. 89-20. Garber abstained; Ausra, Dafler, Duncan, Imler, Keener and Seagraves yeas, motion carried with 6 yeas and 1 abstain.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Keener to appoint three citizens to the Property Maintenance Committee instead of two as originally planned and that Russell, Detoro and Alsop be the three appointed. All yeas, motion carried.

The date of Thursday, October 19, 1989 at 6:30 P.M. was selected as the time to have the organization meeting to be held in the Council Room.

Motion by Dafler, seconded by Garber to go into executive session to discuss proposal on the real estate transaction. All yeas, motion carried.

Mayor Duncan called Council back into regular session.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dafler to adjourn. All yeas, motion carried.
