

BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
SEPTEMBER 19, 1989

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Duncan at 7:30 P.M. on September 19, 1989 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Imler, Keener and Seagraves; Manager Wright and Law Director Zuhl were present with Members Garber and Dafler arriving later.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Imler to accept the Agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to approve the September 5, 1989 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Member Garber arrived.

Stephanie Smith-Gray, Director of Montgomery County Animal Shelter, gave a presentation on the operation of the Animal Shelter and answered various questions concerning the handling of dogs and also held discussion on cats.

Member Dafler arrived during the discussion.

Citizen Comment: Coy Barnett, resident at the corner of Arlington Road and W. Westbrook Road intersection, gave a presentation on the need for stop sign on W. Council agreed to interview citizens for the Property Maintenance Committee on Monday, September 25, 1989 starting at 6:30 P.M.
