

BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING  
MAY 5, 1987

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Vice Mayor Imler at 7:30 P.M. on May 5, 1987 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Duncan, Garber, Imler and Seagraves; Manager Wright and Law Director Zuhl were present with Member Keener arriving late. Mayor Brown was absent.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Garber to accept the Agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Duncan, seconded by Garber to accept the first reading, dispense with the second and third reading and adopt Ordinance No. 1987-04 entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL STOP STREETS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO, SPECIFICALLY AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF ARLINGTON ROAD AND WOLF CREEK PIKE BY MEANS OF ADDING OR CHANGING VARIOUS STOP SIGNS AND YIELD SIGNS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY." All yeas, motion carried.
