

BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
JULY 1, 1986

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Brown at 7:30 P.M. on July 1, 1986 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Duncan, Garber, Imler, Keener and Seagraves; Manager Wright and Law Director Zuhl were present.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Garber to accept the Agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to approve the June 17, 1986 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Citizen Comments: The Grace Brethern Church requested permission to have a parade throughout Brookville.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Ausra to approve request of Grace Brethern Church to have a parade on July 12, 1986 between 9:00 A.M. and 12:00 Noon and approve proposed route around town as presented, subject to having the Police Dept. involved in the parade. All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Ausra, seconded by Imler to have the Law Director prepare a resolution for the next meeting authorizing the transfer of cable television franchise from Jackson Cable Systems to Centel Cable Television Co. All yeas, motion carried.

Work session on the sanitary sewer system plan to be set before the next Council meeting.

Finance Director Roeser gave his report with the following action taken.

Public Hearing on the 1987 Annual Budget, including the Federal Revenue Sharing, set for 8:00 P.M. on July 15, 1986.

Mayor Brown gave his report with no action taken.

Member Duncan reported that 293 children attended the first week of the Mobile Playground Program.

Motion by Duncan to authorize the hiring of an additional patrolman for the Police Department. Motion died for lack of a second to allow Councilman Ausra to review the material along with further study by Council.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to adjourn. All yeas, motion carried.
