

BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING  
OCTOBER 7, 1986

Motion by Ausra, seconded by Imler to accept the September 30, 1986 Fund Balance as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Mayor Brown gave his report with no action taken.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to read proposed Resolution No. 86-17. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to accept the second reading of proposed Resolution No. 86-17. All yeas, motion carried.
