

BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING  
OCTOBER 21, 1986

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Brown at 7:30 P.M. on October 21, 1986 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Duncan, Garber, Imler and Seagraves; Manager Wright and Law Director Zuhl were present. Member Keener was absent.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Imler to accept the agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to approve the October 7, 1986 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Imler to accept the dedication and improvements as presented of the extension of Carr Drive past Mosier Plant and 50 feet in front of Tri-Tech property. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Duncan to place a "Warning Children Playing" sign on Rona Parkway and obtain an additional sign for Rona Village Home-owners Assn. for their placement on their property as they requested. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Imler to authorize Manager Wright to object, on behalf of Council, the transfer of \$10,000 from the Fire Fund to the General Fund as requested by Clay Township at the Montgomery County Common Pleas Court Hearing on October 30, 1986. All yeas, motion carried.

Finance Director Roeser gave his report with the following action taken.

Work Session set for 7:30 P.M. on October 28, 1986 for discussion on ways to finance sewer plant improvement and ways to pay for it.

Mayor Brown gave his report with no action taken.

Reported on meeting held with the Fire Department personnel.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Imler to read proposed Resolution No. 86-17. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Duncan, seconded by Imler to accept the third reading and adopt Resolution No. 86-17 entitled "A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE MANNER IN WHICH LIGHTING OF STREETS, ROADS AND PUBLIC PLACES MAY BE FURNISHED, PROVIDED AND PAID FOR". All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Duncan, seconded by Imler to adjourn. All yeas, motion carried.
