REGULAR MEETING  
AUGUST 20, 1985

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Brown at 7:30 P.M. on August 20, 1985 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Motion by Duncan, seconded by Imler to accept the agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Duncan to approve the August 6, 1985 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Citizen Comments: Complaint on cats running loose and and dirtying up property from citizen corner of Villa and Brookside. Need complaint to police and will follow up.

Betty Dill on behalf of Boy Scouts asking for help to put heat in Boy Scout shelter at park. Need to go to Park Board first.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to list Council, Park Board and Planning Commission meetings on Birthday Calendar for 1986. All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken:

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Imler to accept the low bid of \$16,175.00 from Service Enterprises Corp. to repair and repaint the water tower. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Ausra to accept the only bid of \$1.82 per square foot, with Brookville to keep pavement removed, from John R. Jurgensen Co. for pavement removal. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Weaver to authorize advertising for bid for a new police cruiser to be either a 1985 or 1986. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Seagraves, seconded by Imler to have the law director draft an ordinance for three stop signs and no parking signs on either side on Carr Drive as per police report recommendations. All yeas, motion carried.


Finance Director Roeser gave his report with no action taken.
