

BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING  
MARCH 19, 1985

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Vice Mayor Weaver at 7:30 P.M. on March 19, 1985 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Duncan, Imler, Keener, Seagraves and Weaver; Manager Wright and Law Director Zuhl were present. Mayor Brown and Police Director Rose were absent.

Motion by Duncan, seconded by Imler to accept the agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to approve the March 5, 1985 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken:

Announced that the bridge on the Upper Lewisburg-Salem Road would be closed until completion.

Announced that the hearing on the annexation petition would be June 4, 1985 at 1:30 P.M.

Motion by Ausra, seconded by Seagraves to authorize preparing an ordinance on increase for refuse rates as recommended. All yeas, motion carried.

Reported that the C.I.C. was in the process of being incorporated.

Manager Wright reported on action taken by the Board of Park Trustees on capital improvment to be made this year.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Seagraves to accept the first reading of proposed Ordinance No. 1985-02. All yeas, motion carried.
