The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Brown at 7:30 P.M. on February 21, 1984 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Apgar, Ausra, Imler, Keener, Seagraves and Weaver; Manager Wright, Law Director Zuhl and Police Director Rose were present.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Apgar to approve the February 7, 1984 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Citizen Comments: Dottie Watkins reported on some damage being done in the Mini Park and that it wasn't being locked at night. The Manager will check this out.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Apgar, seconded by Imler to authorize the Manager to enter into a Fire Protection contract with Perry Township for \$36,000 as proposed. All yeas, motion carried.

Work Session to follow Council meeting.

Finance Director Roeser gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Apgar, seconded by Imler to accept the January 31, 1984 Fund Balances as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Agreed to have Warren Vrooman present at the next Council meeting to answer questions on the updating of the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning and that the Development Commission be invited to the meeting.

Mayor Brown gave his report with the following action taken.


Read a Proclamation designating the week of February 18 through February 25, 1984 as FFA week.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Apgar to mark the crosswalks in front of Arlington Arm Apartments by putting signs up on Arlington Road before the crosswalks. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Keener, seconded by Weaver to pay the 1984 TCC assessment of \$648.30. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Apgar to adjourn. All yeas, motion carried.
