The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Brown at 7:30 P.M. on September 18, 1984 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Apgar, Ausra, Imler, Keener, Seagraves and Weaver; Manager Wright, Law Director Zuhl and Police Director Rose were present. Clerk of Council Roeser was absent.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Apgar to accept the agenda as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Apgar to approve the September 4, 1984 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Citizens Comments: Dorothy Watkins was present requesting a post to place a directional sign on pretaining to flight to be placed in front of the Spitler House.

Motion by Apgar, seconded by Imler to grant Watkin's request for a post which will be placed in front of the Spitler House. All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Wright presented his report with the following actions taken:

Motion by Apgar, seconded by Weaver to authorize Manager Wright to purchase a 1984 police cruiser for \$10,200, without bidding, after all details are checked to meet his approval. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Apgar, seconded by Seagraves to set Tuesday, October 30, 1984 from 6:00 to 8:00 P.M. as Beggar's Night. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Weaver to accept the August 31, 1984 Fund Balance as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Mayor Brown read a Proclamation on the 50th Anniversary of the Brookville National Bank, read letters from fourth graders who were referring to the speeches he had given, and called for an executive meeting directly after Council Meeting.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Keener to read proposed Ordinance No. 1984-08. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Weaver, seconded by Ausra to accept the first reading of proposed Ordinance No. 1984-08. All yeas, motion carried.
