REGULAR Meeting

Held

MARCH 1, 19 83

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Apgar at 7:30 P.M. on March 1, 1983 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Brown, Imler, Keener, and Weaver; Manager Wright, Law Director Zuhl, and Police Director Rose were present. Member Dean was absent.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Weaver to approve the February 15, 1983 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken.

Sunday, March 20, 1983 between 1:00 - 4:00 P.M. was scheduled to have open house for the public viewing of the newly remodeled Municipal offices.

Motion by Weaver, seconded by Brown to authorize the Manager to waiver the water and sewer tap-in fees for E.G.I., who will be going into one of Benchmark Home's building, since service had been in the building and paid previously, but service is now not large enough. All yeas, motion carried.

Discussion was held on proposed water and sewer rate increases.

Public Hearing was held at 8:10 P.M. with the Planning Commission members regarding the rezoning of property at 375 Baker Street from R-1 to R-4. One citizen had several questions and the property owner also asked questions. After no objections and no other discussion the hearing was closed.

Mayor Apgar gave his report with the following action taken.

Presented a Proclamation to designate the week of March 7 through March 11, 1983 as "Brookville Right To Read Week".

Motion by Ausra, seconded by Imler to have the Manager check out the possibilities and have the Municipal Seal constructed in color to be hung in the Council Chambers. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Weaver to adjourn. All yeas, motion carried.
