The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Apgar at 7:30 P.M. on September 20, 1983 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Imler, Keener, and Weaver; Manager Wright and Police Director Rose were present. Members Ausra, Brown, and Dean and Law Director Zuhl were absent.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Keener to approve the September 6, 1983 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Weaver to authorize the blocking of Orchard Street from Westbrook to Simmons as needed for an auction on October 15, 1983. All yeas, motion carried.

Finance Director Roeser gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Weaver, seconded by Imler to accept the August 31, 1983 Fund Balance as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Mayor Apgar gave his report with the following action taken.

Mayor Apgar read the Proclamation proclaiming the week of September 30, 1983 through October 7, 1983 as Brookville Fire Dept. Week.

Motion by Keener, seconded by Weaver to set October 31, 1983 from 6:00 to 8:00 P.M. as Beggar's Night. All yeas, motion carried.

Mayor Apgar read an invitation from the Brookville Fire Dept. to Council for their 100th Anniversary Celebration to be held on September 30, October 1 and October 2, 1983 and ask the Members to ride in the parade.

Mayor Apgar appointed Imler, Keener and himself as a committee to check on how to handle the towing within the Village and report back to Council with a recommendation.

Mayor Apgar announced there would be an executive meeting immediately following the Council meeting.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Weaver to adjourn. All yeas, motion carried.
