The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Apgar at 7:30 P.M. on April 6, 1982 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Brown, Dean, Imler, Keener and Weaver; Manager Wright were present. Law Director Zuhl was absent.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dean to approve the March 16, 1982 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Citizen Comments: Carl Roberts questioned the necessity of mandatory filing as required for city income tax as it creates more work for the tax consultant filling out papers when no tax was due. Discussion followed.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Dean, seconded by Imler to authorize the Manager to sign the new contract with the Preble County Landfill for \$6.60 per ton for disposing of refuse. All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Wright reported that Ptl. Mark Summers was promoted to Sergeant in the Police Department on April 1, 1982.

Clerk-Finance Director Roeser gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Brown, seconded by Dean to authorize the passage of a Resolution, that is to be drawn up, in support of the three (3) amendments proposed to be added to House Bill No. 872 regarding the county permissive motor vehicle registration fee and mailed to members of the House Committee and local representatives. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Apgar, seconded by Dean to table payment of \$648.30 for TCC 1982 annual membership assessment. All yeas, motion carried.


Mayor Apgar gave his report with no action taken.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dean to read proposed Resolution #82-13. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Dean, seconded by Imler to accept the first reading, dispense with the second and third reading and adopt Resolution #82-13 entitled "A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF CONSTRUCTING, REPLACING AND REPAIRING CERTAIN SIDEWALKS AND CURBS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO, AND REQUIRING ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS TO CONSTRUCT, REPAIR AND REPLACE THE SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY." All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dean to adjourn. All yeas, motion carried.
