The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Apgar at 7:30 P.M. on August 3, 1982 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Dean, Keener and Weaver; Manager Wright were present. Members Brown and Imler; and Law Director Zuhl were absent.

Motion by Dean, seconded by Keener to approve the July 20, 1982 regular meeting minutes as presented with correction. All yeas, motion carried.

Citizens Comments: 1) David Seagraves announced the opening of a Pre-School Day Care Center starting September 13, 1982 with Becky Parks as director. 2) James Boomershine, Principal of Westbrook School, presented a certificate of appreciation for the Fire Department to Manager Wright. 3) Joyce Young introduced herself to Council as a candidate for County Commissioner. 4) Dottie Watkins informed Council of the auction during the Community Picnic of items donated for sale by various officials and public people. 5) Informed of pig roast and beer sales with some complaints of beer at the Community Picnic.

Discussion followed on the beer sales, area to be sold and consumed and also on the picnic being downtown.

Manager Wright had no report.

Clerk-Finance Director Roeser gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Dean, seconded by Weaver to accept the June 30, 1982 Fund Balance as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Mayor Apgar gave his report and announced that the flag presentation would be held at 10:00 A.M. on Saturday, August 7, 1982 at the Brook Court Apartments.

At 8:00 P.M. the Public Hearing on the Jackson Cable T.V. rate increase and services was held. A representative of Jackson Cable T.V. was present and discussion was held mostly on services and whether the rate increase was justified. After approximately ten minutes the hearing closed.

Manager Wright reported on the picnic clean-up plans during and after; the Westbrook Road project paving to be done; and street sweeper purchased.

Motion by Ausra, seconded by Dean to adjourn. All yeas, motion carried.
