The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Apgar at 7:30 P.M. on November 3, 1982 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Brown, Dean, Imler, Keener and Weaver; Manager Wright and Law Director Zuhl were present.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Ausra to approve the October 19, 1982 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Citizen Comments: Willis Schwartz questioned the revising of the ordinance regarding the alley behind Rowe's Carry-Out along with other citizen present. After much discussion, it was decided to check the alley width and location and then have a public hearing on subject.

Nick Kline was present with complaints about the Westbrook Road Project: 1) Property owners losing front lawn and trees. 2) Poor workmanship on sidewalks, curbs and retainer walls. 3) Assessments to property owners too high. After discussion, it was decided to re-check the assessment amounts, check work and then get back to property owners.
