Minutes of BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Apgar at 7:30 P.M. on October 19, 1982 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Brown, Dean, Imler, Keener and Weaver; Municipal Manager Wright and Law Director Zuhl were present.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dean to approve the October 5, 1982 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Citizen Comments: Bud Dill on behalf of the Boy Scouts expressed their thanks to the various officials and municipal employees for their cooperation and help during the Boy Scouts campout last weekend at Golden Gate Park.

Randy Rowe and Cy Magoto questioned the value of an ordinance passed at the last council meeting making an alley one-way as it has created some problems.

Motion by Brown, seconded by Dean to read proposed Ordinance #1982-14. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Dean, seconded by Imler to accept the first reading, dispense with the second and third reading and adopt Ordinance #1982-14 entitled "AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE 1982-13 WHICH AUTHORIZED AND DECREED A ONE-WAY ALLEY AND THE PLACEMENT OF VARIOUS ONE-WAY SIGNS, IN THE ALLEY PARALLEL TO MARKET AND MAIN STREET BETWEEN JEFFERSON AND COLUMBIA STREET IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY." All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Keener, seconded by Imler to deny the request from John Hoops to block Market Street on October 23, 1982 for lack of information and no one present with information. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Weaver to approve the site construction plans and specifications as recommended by the Manager for the Brookville Full Gospel Church of God on Wolf Creek Street property, subject to changes made as per Planning Commission in the plans. Keener nay; Ausra, Brown, Dean, Imler, Weaver and Apgar yeas, motion carried with 1 nay and 6 yeas.

Law Director Zuhl gave his report with no action taken.

Mayor Apgar gave his report with the following action taken.

Presented a Proclamation declaring November 7 through November 13 as "Youth Appreciation Week".

Member Brown reported on the Planning Commission meeting.

Member Weaver reported on the MVRPC meeting.
