REGULAR Meeting

Held

DECEMBER 15, 1981

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Apgar at 7:30 P.M. on December 15, 1981 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Bailey, Brown, Dean, Imler, and Weaver; Manager Wright and Law Director Zuhl were present.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Ausra to approve the December 1, 1981 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Law Director Zuhl gave his report with no action taken.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Ausra, seconded by Imler to prepare an ordinance to create a three way stop at the entrance of Brook Court at Rona Parkway. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Dean, seconded by Imler to authorize payment of \$216.10 to the Miami Valley Disaster Service Authority as requested. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Dean, seconded by Imler to authorize the carry over of the employee's 1981 vacation days not used into 1982. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Brown, seconded by Weaver to authorize the Manager to draft a letter expressing Council's objection to Conrail's possible abandonment of railroad through Brookville and supporting any local action to help keep the rail service open through Brookville. All yeas, motion carried.

Clerk-Finance Director Roeser gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Brown to accept the November 30, 1981 Fund Balance as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Dean, seconded by Imler to authorize payment of \$451.00 to Montgomery County Council on Aging as requested for Brookville's contribution. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Ausra, seconded by Imler to accept the bids of Brookville National Bank and The Central Trust Co. as depositories for the Brookville Municipal Funds, both active and inactive for the two year period beginning January 1, 1982. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Dean, seconded by Imler to voice "Does Not Object" on liquor permit applications received from the Department of Liquor Control for the following three: Peffley's Cafe Inc., Mary Alice Kramer Ries's "Our Place" and V.F.W. Post. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dean to "Object and request hearing in the County Seat" on liquor permit application received from the Department of Liquor Control for Ted Pifer, "Palace Restaurant" and send a letter stating the reasons for objections is that there is no business located at the stated address. All yeas, motion carried.

Mayor Apgar gave his report with no action taken.

Mayor Apgar wished the citizens a Merry Christmas from Council and thanked Judy Bailey for her service on Council the past two years.
