The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Apgar at 7:40 P.M. on June 2, 1981 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Bailey, Dean, Imler and Weaver; Manager Wright, Police Director Jackson and Law Director Zuhl were present. Member Brown was absent.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Ausra to approve the May 19, 1981 regular meeting minutes as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken.

Reported that Arby's are not going to build this year and that proposed cost of stop light, turn lane, etc. at Triggs and Arlington Roads intersection is estimated at \$54,000.00.

Motion by Dean, seconded by Bailey to authorize blocking off the Municipal Parking lot on June 20, 1981 from 6:00 P.M. to 12:00 midnight for a free dance to be sponsored by the V.F.W. and certain area merchants. All yeas, motion carried.

Finance Director Roeser gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dean to accept the second reading of proposed Ordinance #1981-2. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Dean, seconded by Imler to accept the second reading of proposed Ordinance #1981-3. All yeas, motion carried.
