The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Apgar at 7:30 P.M. on April 15, 1980 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Bailey, Brown, Dean, Imler and Weaver; Manager Wright and Law Director Gowdown were present. Police Director Jackson was absent.

The April 1, 1980 regular meeting minutes were read, corrections noted and approved upon being properly signed.

Citizens Comments: Robert Mozingo of the CWA, AFL-CIO presented a letter stating that in excess of 60% of the municipal employees support the CWA, AFL-CIO as their bargaining agent and he requested that negotiations begin on a contract for employees.

Motion by Brown, seconded by Weaver to request that an un-biased individual chosen by Council and agreed upon by Mr. Mozingo be given the opportunity to evaluate the signatures presented to Mr. Mozingo, for verification as to the number of employees of the Municipality of Brookville interested in representation by the CWA, AFL-CIO. Weaver, Bailey & Brown yea; Ausra, Dean, Imler & Apgar nay; 3 yeas, 4 mays, motion failed.

Motion by Ausra, seconded by Dean to authorize the Municipal Manager to find out how to get the signatures validated officially, [then have it done and present the verification results to Council.] [All contacts to be made before the next Council meeting.] All yeas, motion carried. *1/1/80

Citizens Comments continued: A citizen complained about an abandon car on private property and discussion was held.

Several citizens on Bayview Avenue asked about what could be done about the flooding in their neighborhood and discussion followed.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Brown to accept the low bid for cleaning and painting the water tower of Great Lakes Tank & Steel, Inc. in the amount of \$6,570.00. All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Wright announced that the consultant will start work the second week of May on employee's wage scale and etc.

Law Director Gowdown gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Ausra to authorize the payment of \$125.00 for a preliminary printing of a book of the ordinance codification for Council to examine before final printing. All yeas, motion carried.

Clerk-Finance Director Roeser gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Ausra to accept the March 31, 1980 Fund Balance as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Mayor Apgar gave his report with the following action taken.

He read Proclamation proclaiming April 30 through May 6, 1980 to be Youth-In Government Days.

Motion by Apgar, seconded by Ausra to adopt Written Motion #80-1 entitled "AUTHORIZATION FOR YOUTH IN GOVERNMENT STUDENTS OF BROOKVILLE HIGH SCHOOL TO RIDE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE VEHICLES DURING THE PERIOD OF APRIL 30th THRU MAY 6, 1980." All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Ausra, seconded by Imler to have the third reading of proposed Ordinance #1980-3. All yeas, motion carried.
