REGULAR Meeting

Held

JULY 15, 1980

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Apgar at 7:30 P.M. on July 15, 1980 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Dean, Imler and Weaver; Manager Wright, Police Director Jackson and Law Director Gowdown were present. Members Bailey and Brown were absent.

The July 1, 1980 regular meeting minutes were read and approved upon being properly signed.

Citizens Comments: Several citizens from Sycamore Street were present asking for something to be done about the water problems on that street. Discussion followed.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Dean, seconded by Ausra to table the traffic count on Arlington and Triggs Road intersection. All yeas, motion carried.

Police Director Jackson gave his report on the police activities for the month of June.

Law Director Gowdown gave his report with no action taken.

Clerk-Finance Director Roeser gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dean to accept the June 30, 1980 Fund Balance as presented. All yeas, motion carried.

Mayor Apgar had no report, but asked if there were any questions for him, no action taken.

Motion by Ausra, seconded by Dean to read proposed Ordinance #1980-8. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Ausra, seconded by Dean to accept the third reading and adopt Ordinance #1980-8 entitled "AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A POLICY WITH REGARD TO RELATIONS WITH ORGANIZED EMPLOYEES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKVILLE AND PROHIBITING STRIKES BY SUCH EMPLOYEES." Member Imler asked several questions with much discussion by all of Council plus citizen input. Weaver nay; Ausra, Dean, Imler and Apgar yea, motion carried with 4 yeas, 1 nay.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dean to adjourn. All yeas, motion carried.
