Minutes of BROOKVILLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL

SEPTEMBER 16, 1980

The regular meeting of the Brookville Municipal Council was called to order by Mayor Apgar at 7:30 P.M. on September 16, 1980 in the Municipal Council Chambers. Members Ausra, Bailey, Brown, Dean, Imler and Weaver; Manager Wright and Law Director Zuhl were present. Police Director Jackson was absent.

The September 2, 1980 regular meeting minutes were read and approved upon being properly signed.

Motion by Apgar, seconded by Imler to post minutes in the hallway of the Municipal Building and have copies available for citizens instead of reading the minutes at council meetings. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Apgar, seconded by Dean to authorize the blocking off of various streets for Fire Prevention Day, same as in previous years. All yeas, motion carried.

Manager Wright gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dean to contribute to the Ombudsman's office the same amount as last year, but not to exceed \$100.00 whichever is smaller. All yeas, motion carried.

Motion by Dean, seconded by Imler to authorize installation of six street lights on Rona Parkway as per D.P.&L. recommendations. All yeas, motion carried.

Law Director Zuhl gave report on liquor license hearing and permissive license tax monies, no action taken.

Clerk-Finance Director Roeser asked for codification books be returned so those can be brought up to date.

Mayor Apgar gave his report with the following action taken.

Motion by Imler, seconded by Dean to have October 30, 1980 from 6:00 to 8:00 P.M. as Beggar's Night. All yeas, motion carried.

Member Brown reported on the September 9, 1980 Park Board meeting, minutes are on file in the Clerk's Office.

Motion by Dean, seconded by Imler to amend the parking ordinance and make the southwest side of Bayview and Brookmoor starting from the driveway at 85 Bayview and south to ten feet north of the driveway at 112 Brookmoor a "NO PARKING" zone. Brown abstained; Apgar, Ausra, Bailey, Dean, Imler and Weaver yea, motion carried with 6 yeas and 1 abstain.

Member Dean brought up the question on the possible additional septic tanks at the end of Walnut Street. Discussion followed.

Motion by Ausra, seconded by Dean to adjourn. All yeas, motion carried.
